PCRC FLYING FIELD RULES

(Revised August 2008)

- 1. AMA membership is required for all flying members.
- 2. Only AMA members are allowed in the pit area.
- 3. Your AMA membership card and PCRC membership card must be in your possession while flying at all PCRC fields.
- 4. All members must use frequency pins during the operation of a transmitter, including 2.4 GHz radios.
- 5. All new members must have a check flight by a club-qualified instructor before their first solo flight.
- 6. You must have your name, address and AMA number in all of your models.
- 7. No glow or gas flying is allowed before 9:00 AM.
- 8. No flying after dark is allowed, unless preapproved.
- 9. No use of alcoholic beverage is allowed at PCRC fields.
- 10. No taxiing into the pit area.
- 11. All members must use the same side of the runway at any one time.
- 12. All models must be held by a PCRC approved restraint while starting in the pit area.
- 13. No flying is permitted over the pit area, shelter, sheds or parking lot.
- 14. Helicopter or control line flying must be planned with other flyers so that no one is positioned on the runway area while others are flying.
- 15. No flying over the college building or Interstate 81 at the Lord Fairfax flying site. (Note: this flying site is not currently being used by PCRC)
- 16. If you must go onto the runway to retrieve your plane, make absolutely sure that all other flyers are aware of your intentions, and clear the runway as soon as possible if other aircraft are in the air.
- 17. You must abide by club rules at each PCRC Club flying site, as they may be different at each site.
- 18. All accidents which cause personal or property damage must be reported to the Safety Officer or President immediately.
